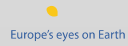

GODAE – the vision in 1997

Development of a global system of observations, communications, modeling and assimilation to provide regular, comprehensive ocean forecasts & analyses for maximum benefit of society

GODAE OceanView – the plan of 2009

Improvement and exploitation of operational ocean forecast systems for societal benefit, sustaining and enhancing of the global ocean observing system, and integration with the international ocean community

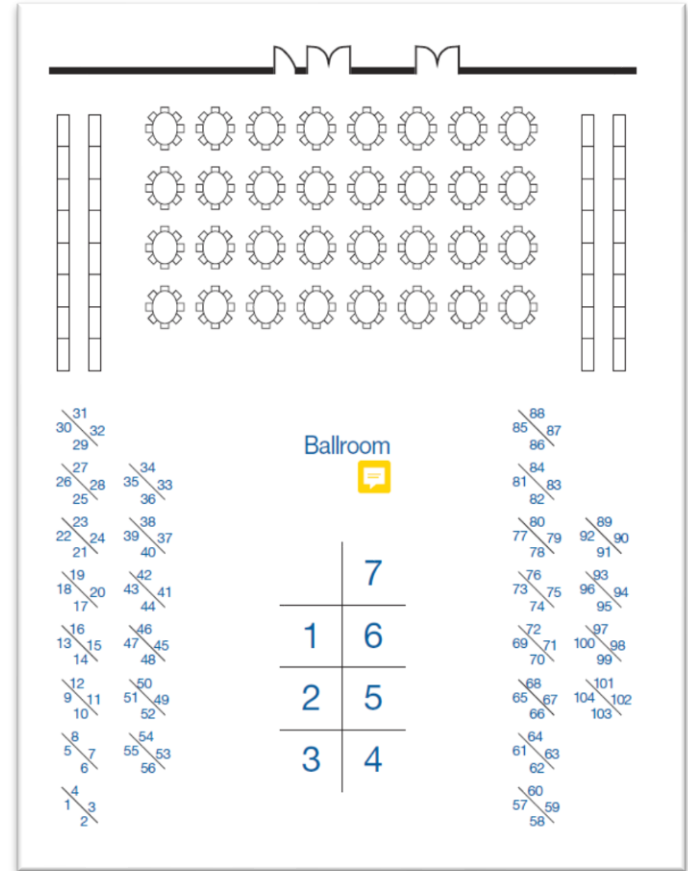
